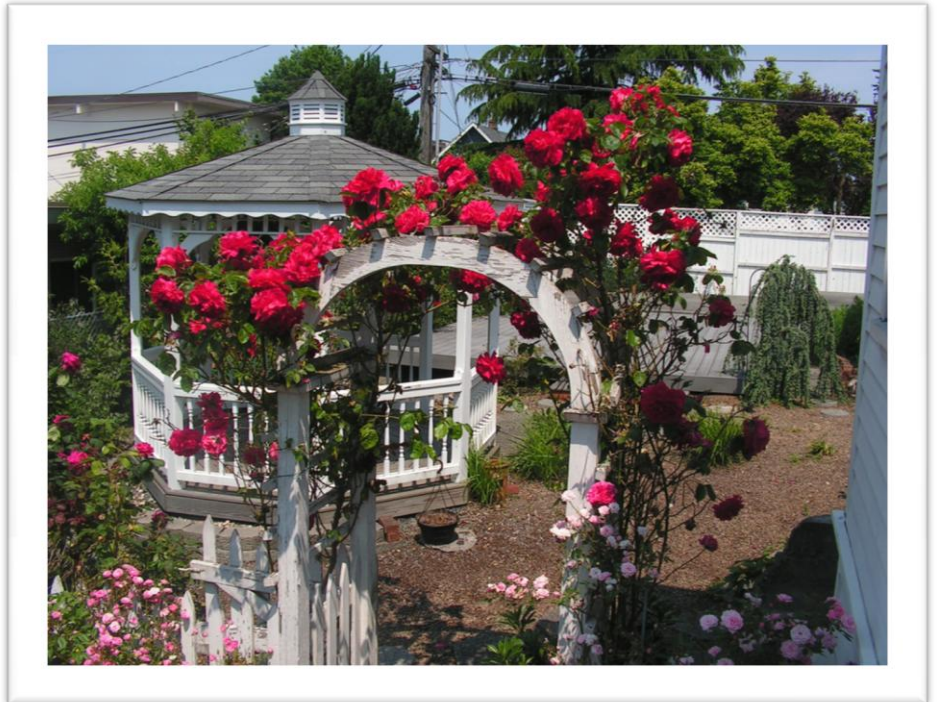

The current exhibition will be available to view during the Edmonds Art Festival/Father's Day weekend and is located less than a block from the festival grounds. It will remain at the house through the month of June and into July.



More about the Rose House:

Built in 1907, this elegant Victorian house is one of Edmonds' oldest remaining structures, named by the Washington Trust for Historic Preservation as one of eight buildings on its Most Endangered Historic Properties list. Currently, a campaign is being waged to preserve the house and make it an art center for the community.
